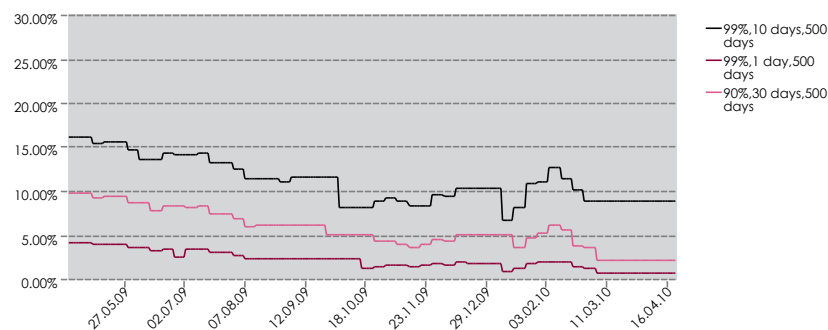
VaR over time

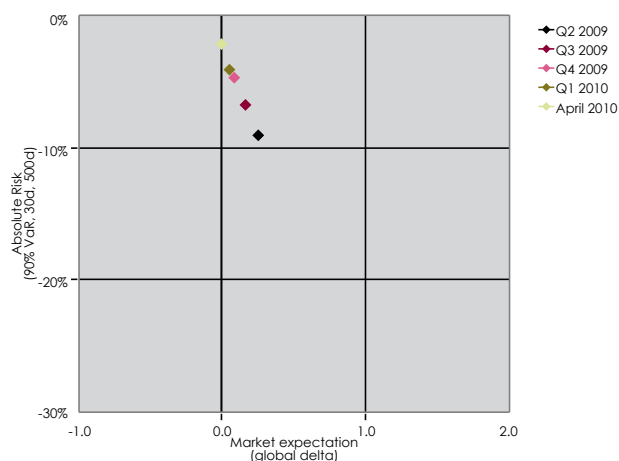
